2nd September: World Coconut Day.

The World Coconut Day (WCD) is observed every year on September 2. It is celebrated as World Coconut Day to commemorate the formation day of Asian Pacific Coconut Community (APCC).

2018 theme: ‘Coconut for Good Health, Wealth & Wellness’.

5th September: International Day of Charity.

The International Day of Charity is observed annually on 5 September. It was declared by the United Nations General Assembly in 2012.

5th September: National Teacher's Day.

India celebrates National Teacher's Day on September 5 every year.

In India, Teacher's Day is celebrated in honour of Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, who was born on September 5, 1888, an Indian philosopher and statesman who was the first Vice President of India and the second President of India.

8th September: International Literacy Day.

International literacy day is observed on 8th September. It was declared international literacy day by UNESCO on 26 October 1966 at 14th session of UNESCO's General conference.

14th September: Hindi Divas.

Hindi Divas or Hindi day (हिन्दी दिवस) is an annual day celebrated on 14 September in India.

It is celebrated on 14 September because on this day in 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India had adopted Hindi written in Devanagari script as the official language of the Republic of India.

15th September: International Day of Democracy.

The International Day of Democracy is observed on 15th September.

2018 Theme: Democracy under Strain: Solutions for a Changing World.

15th September: Engineer's Day.

Engineer's Day is celebrated every year on 15th September.

28th September: World Rabies Day.

International Translation Day is celebrated every year on 30 September on the feast of St. Jerome, the Bible translator who is considered the patron saint of translators.
